Fire Protection Engineering Positions

Position Description:

The full performance level of this position will include, but will not be limited to the following:

- Review, evaluate, and oversee the management of fire protection activities at Department of Energy (DOE) facilities.
- Oversee contractors in developing and implementing fire protection engineering programs that will assure an "improved risk" level of fire protection sufficient to meet DOE objectives.
- Provide professional fire protection engineering advice and assistance to program and facility managers and other managers and staff through the DOE.
- Review and confirm adequacy of fire protection policies, standards, and requirements supporting the safe conduct of work and operations.
- Conduct administrative and technical reviews on proposals, plans, reports, drawings, safety analysis, and procedures.
- Make field inspections of proposed projects to determine fire protection system design requirements.
- Conduct frequent on-site performance based evaluations of fire protection activities through observation of work being performed, discussions with contractor staff, inspection of equipment, and review of operations, maintenance, safety, and records.

The purpose of this position is to provide developmental work experience. The incumbent would work independently on continuing assignments or projects and with higher graded staff on more comprehensive positions/phases of projects. More responsible work is assigned as proficiency is demonstrated.

About the EMPDC Internship Program:

Our EMPDC is a structured program of on-the-job training, formal training, and developmental assignments to create a new generation of technical expertise and future leadership. The internship program is designed to provide a continuing source of highly competent personnel with the skills and knowledge to meet our current and future staffing needs. It also affords us the ability to assess, develop and nurture candidates to serve as future leaders and managers within EM, the Department of Energy and the Federal government.
