Employee will be responsible for performing field inspections as the professional engineer member of a team assigned to complex structures; conducting fire detection and suppression system tests; ensuring building components are in compliance with fire safety specifications; providing full-performance on-site review, advice and direction to contractor professionals to resolve post-installation problems and ensuring compliance with applicable engineering principles and practices, and applicable fire and life safety codes, laws, and policies.

License and registration as a Professional Engineer is preferred.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's Degree and 3 years of experience in an engineering field appropriate to Fire Protection Engineering. Registration as a Professional Engineer may substitute for the Bachelor's degree. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be substituted provided such combination includes 60 accredited semester hours (or an equivalent amount of accredited professional training) in engineering or related courses appropriate to Fire Protection Engineering. License and registration as a Professional Engineer (Bachelor's Degree in Engineering with Engineer in Training or NICET Technologist certification may substitute for the Professional Engineer license and certification.) Equivalency applies.
